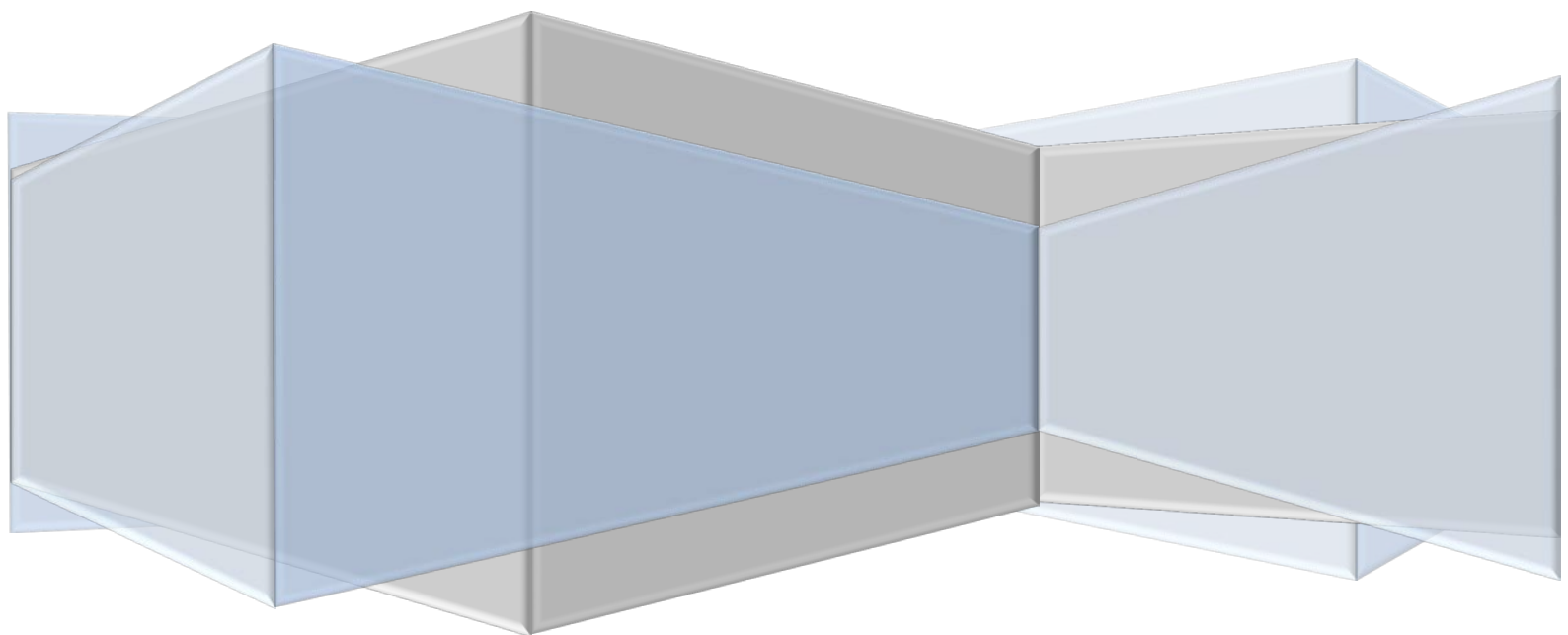

How to configure a Mac Device to Open DNS



Open DNS

Open DNS provides a cloud-delivered network security services, delivering automated protection against advanced attacks for any device, no matter where it is. Family shield is pre-configured to block adult content, you can set it up and forget about it.

How to Configure

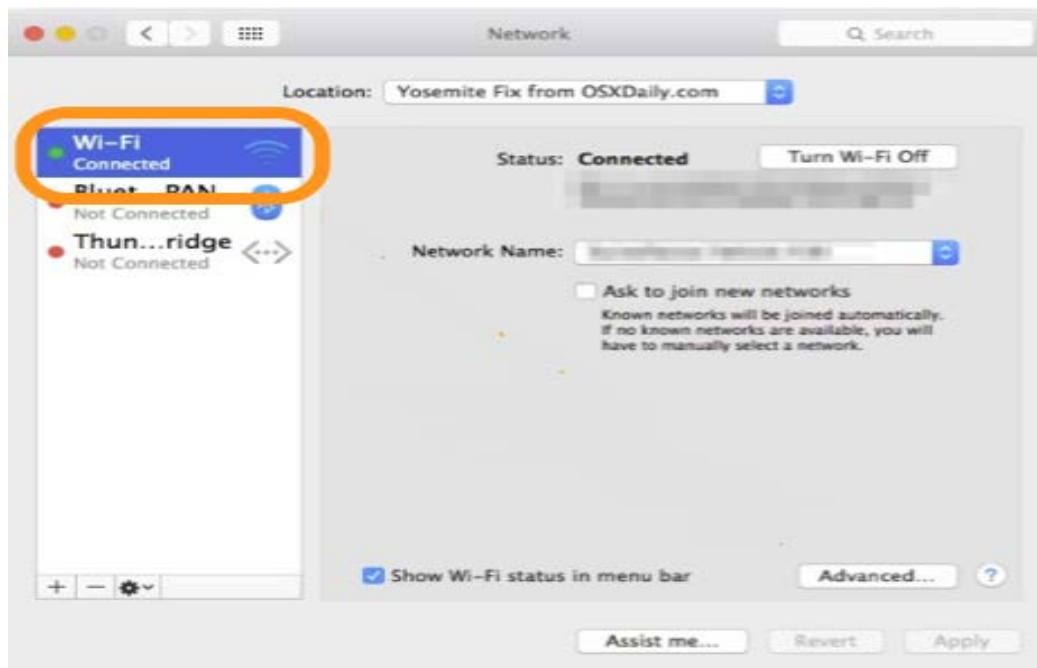
1. Go to **Apple Menu**.
2. Choose **System Preferences**.



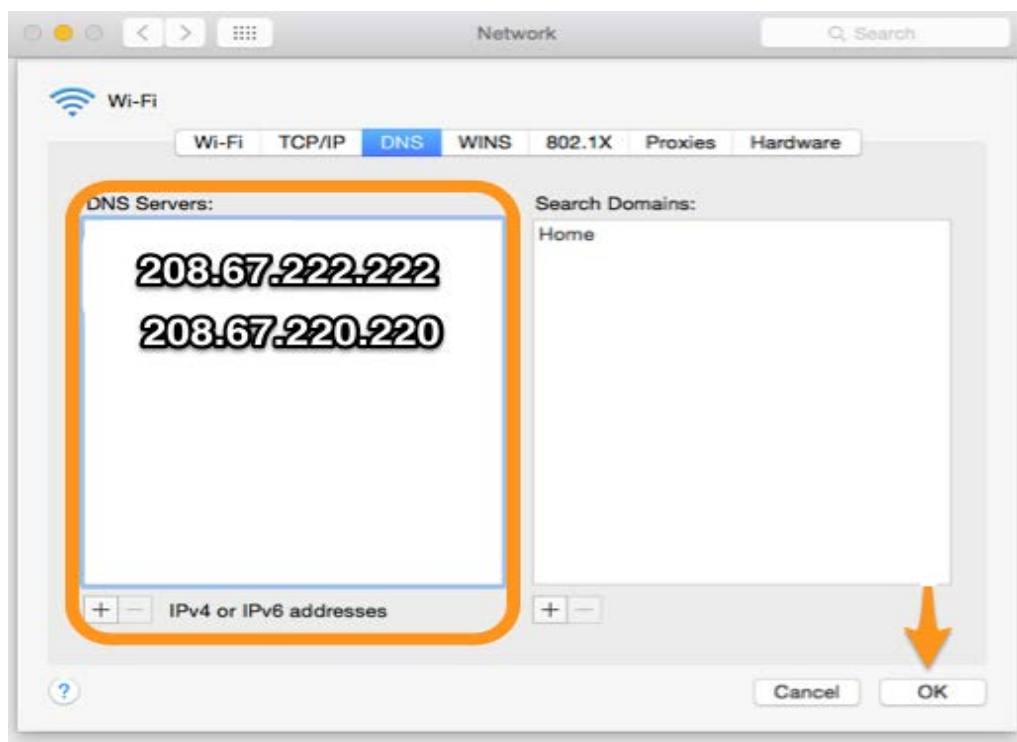
3. Select **Network**.



4. Highlight first connection in the light.
5. Click on **advanced**.



6. Choose the **DNS tab** at the top.
7. Ignore any greyed out IP addresses.
8. **Input Open DNS server Addresses.**
9. Click **OK**.



10. Flush DNS and Browser cache.
11. Click on **terminal icon** in the dock.
12. **OR** type in search box: **Application/Utilities/Terminal**.
13. Type in: **sudo discoveryutil mdnsflushcache; sudo discoveryutil udnsflushcaches; say flushed**
